Seven Dates with Death lays open the soul of Moreese Bickham, a man who endured 38 years at Louisiana's infamous Angola Prison and seven execution dates to finally greet freedom with forgiveness and grace.

In his own words, Bickham, the nation's oldest living survivor of Death Row, ushers the viewer of this intimate short documentary deep into his incredible and agonizing journey.

At age 98, Bickham is direct and endearing as he shares his life from Jim Crow to Death Row to become a free man in a world transformed from the one he left at age 41.

Seven Dates with Death has been the Official Selection at The Santa Barbara International Film Festival (February 2017); The Discover Film Festival in London (April 2017); The Minneapolis International Film Festival (April 2017) and was screened on Opening Night at The National Film Festival for Talented Youth (NFFTY) in Seattle (April 2017) and the San Francisco Black Film Festival (June 2017).
